

What we do

We provide support to our school, our students, and our school community through a range of services and programs to enhance our students overall school experience.

We also help build a strong sense of school community by engaging our parent community in a range of programs and initiatives.

The MW P&C is responsible for the successful operations of the before and after school care (BASC), canteen, uniform shop, and band program.

Our profits are reinvested back to the school community to ensure we continue to provide quality services to meet demand.

We also support the school's Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden program and provide a range of programs and initiatives to engage our parent community too.

We further support the student's overall school experience and well-being through fundraising to assist with facilities, equipment, and awareness programs.

Our Services

We provide a range of services that support Manly West students including:

- uniform
- canteen
- before and after school care (BASC)
- band program (Years 3-6 only).

We also have special interest groups that focus on:

- enrichment programs and special presentations
- environmental and sustainability projects
- events and fundraising activities
- kitchen garden maintenance
- sun smart compliance and awareness.

In addition, we also have a dedicated **Class Parent Coordinator** to help keep everyone informed of current news and activities.

The following pages explain these services in more detail.

Getting Started

First things first. The P&C can help you and your child prepare for school. You can buy your school uniforms, place lunch orders, and register for quality before and after school care.

Uniform

The Manly West Uniform Shop stocks our complete range of uniform items and accessories and offers a selection of second-hand items to purchase.

For all new Kindy starters orders can be placed via our new online store and collected from the school office or the uniform shop during opening hours. Parents will be notified via email as to when their order is ready for collection. Orders placed in 2023 can be delivered to your child's classroom.

Orders take up to 48 hours to process. Orders placed before the 30 October will be ready for collection from the uniform shop on 31 October - Kindergarten Orientation Day 1.

Our onsite store is open twice a week. Besides from new uniforms, we stock second-hand items that can be purchased at heavily discounted prices. Please visit the uniform shop to pick up a bargain.

What to wear

A complete list of uniform options is available on our online store. We have a suggested Kindy starter pack available for both boys and girls in a range of sizes. The suggested pack is a recommendation only. You can pick and choose your items depending on your child's needs.

Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4

Winter uniform is worn in Terms 2 and 3.

There is a two-week grace period at the start of Terms 2 and 4 for the changeover of uniform.

How to Order

There are three options for purchasing uniforms:

- The fastest and preferred option is through our new Manly West online store. https://manly-west-public-school-uniform-shop.myshopify.com/
- The second is to download the order form from the Manly West P&C website and email your order to uniform@manlywestpandc.org.au
- And the third option is in person at the uniform shop.

Payment Options

The uniform shop will accept, Cash, Visa and Mastercard payments. Our online store accepts Visa and Mastercard payments only.

Shop Opening Times

Our shop is open during school terms on Monday and Wednesday mornings from 8:45am – 10:00am. We also open on the pupil free days at the start of Terms 1, 2 and 3.

Opening times will be listed on the door of the uniform shop and can be found on the Manly West school web site.

- Via Flexischools Order before 9am each day.

Kindy Special Day

Kindy Kids have a special orientation day to learn how the canteen works and from then they are free to order those tasty treats at recess and lunch.

Orders for lunch are to be placed with the canteen before 9:00am.

Volunteering

The canteen really is the place to be. The kettle is always on, and the conversation runs freely. You'll also receive free snacks, tastings and canteen vouchers as an incentive!

Volunteers help keep our doors open and keep our prices down and introduce more "green" strategies so please consider helping out.

We need at least 2 volunteers in the morning and 2 volunteers in the afternoons every day.

Everyone is welcome! Parents, carers, grandparents, aunts, and uncles are all welcome. You can sign-up for as little as a shift a year or even choose a weekly or monthly commitment.

- 12:00pm-2:00pm

Before and After School Care (BASC)

Manly West Before and After School Care is an Approved Childcare provider. Child Care Subsidy is available to eligible children.

We are currently licensed to offer care for 210 children each morning and afternoon. We also offer care on the pupil free days in Terms 1, 2 and 3.

Quality and Engaging Care

The MW BASC is highly regarded amongst the school and wider community. We offer high quality, not-for-profit before and after school care to the families of Manly West.

Children participate in a range of activities including craft, sport, cooking, drama, games and much more. The Centre also offers incursions where specialist providers provide diverse and inspiring activities in which children can participate.

Special theme days are run throughout the year including picnics, parties, and appearances by special guests to celebrate various occasions. Parents are notified of these special occasions in advance.

Rates and Hours

Before School Care 7:00am to 9:00am \$14.10 After School Care 3:20pm to 6:30pm \$22.70

Child Care Subsidy is available to eligible children.

Enrolments and Waitlists

All Manly West families are eligible to enrol at BASC. Please be aware that there are waiting lists for BASC places across all year groups from kindergarten through to Year 6. Should you require care please notify the BASC administration as soon as possible.

Whilst we do try to offer places to all families - registering your child does not guarantee a place.

- 6. **Immunisations** not required
- 7. iPay Request Enter your preferred Payment Method for direct debit
- 8. CLICK SUBMIT

The Fun Stuff

Band

The multi award winning MW Band program is a big part of the MW community and is available to students from Year 3 onwards. There are four wind/brass ensembles – the training band, intermediate band, performance band and concert band. Students in K-2 will be entertained by the bands at assemblies and special events throughout the year.

Enrichment Programs and Special Presentations

Our team coordinates enrichment programs for students and their families. Some are regular like our Interrelate presentations and our Cybersafety talks. Others include workshops with leading artists and authors, and entrepreneurial workshops for our budding enthusiasts – it really depends on the interests of our committee members at the time.

Environmental and Sustainability Projects

Our committee researches and investigates ways the school can reduce waste and be more energy efficient and introduced Waste-free Wednesdays in 2021.

Events and Fundraising

Our events and fundraising teams provide a range of key social and fundraising events and initiatives each year to help build the sense of school community and to raise much needed funds for the school.

Regular events include the Easter Morning Tea, Mothers' and Carers' Day stall and fun parent and student events. Our biennial carnival is like no other on the Northern Beaches.

Kitchen Garden

The Kitchen Garden program is a place where our garden grows and so do our students!

The P&C maintains the Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden. The garden supports a range of curriculum areas across several key learning areas, and it is often referred to as our 'outdoor classroom'. All students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will have an opportunity to use this outdoor classroom throughout the year.

The Kitchen Garden program provides an opportunity for students to plant, harvest, prepare and share food grown.
